PHARMACY 90-DAY SUPPLY

University of Maryland Medical System Health Plans cover a 90-day supply on many formulary generic medications to treat several chronic conditions listed below:

Condition	Medication Class
Asthma/COPD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> LABA/ICS combinations Anticholinergics Anticholinergic/Beta-Agonist combinations
Hypertension	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ACE Inhibitors Angiotensin II Receptor Blockers (ARBs)
Diabetes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Insulin Biguanide DPP4 inhibitors Sulfonylureas Incretin mimetics Meglitinides SGLT2 inhibitors Thiazolidinediones
Hyperlipidemia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Statins Fibrates

Note: Any ineligible 90-day prescriptions will automatically be converted to a 30-day supply with refills.

If the medication is new for your patient, please write an initial prescription up to a 30-day supply. After you have evaluated your patient and determined the medication is the correct drug at the right dose, we are asking you to prescribe a 90-day supply (with three refills, if appropriate). Patients can take their 90-day prescriptions to an in-network retail pharmacy.
